



Centenary Motorway and Logan Motorway interchange upgrade project

November 2022

Community update

In July 2022 the Department of Transport and Main Roads (TMR) commenced an upgrade to the Centenary Motorway and Logan Motorway interchange.

This section of the Centenary Motorway experiences heavy congestion, particularly during the morning peak period where two northbound lanes merge into a single lane through the interchange, and then merge back into two lanes.

Construction commenced in July 2022 and is expected to finish by mid-2023, construction, site and weather conditions permitting.

Key features

- This interchange upgrade project will see northbound lanes increase from one lane to two lanes through this section.
- Work to widen pavements, install new guardrails and concrete barriers, relocate light poles, move the median and remove the gantry.

Benefits

The key benefits of the interchange upgrade include:

- improved safety
- improved network efficiency and travel time
- reduced interchange queuing
- reduced peak hour congestion.

Funding

As part of the \$400 million road stimulus package, the Queensland Government committed \$15 million for the upgrade to support *The Queensland Economic Recovery Strategy: Building Queensland* by driving investment in the infrastructure that supports our recovery, resilience and future prosperity.

Construction

- While majority of the works will be undertaken at night, from **7pm to 5am Sunday to Thursday**, some daytime activities may occur within the project site.
- Night works will help prevent extensive delays on the road network.
- Changed traffic conditions will include reduced speed limits through the site, temporary lane and shoulder closures and delays.
- Due to construction requirements, detours and temporary full ramp closures will occur at various stages of the project.
- Traffic control and signage will be in place as required. Please follow the directions and allow extra time when planning your travel.
- TMR will be in contact with residents and businesses who may be impacted by short term noise, light and dust from construction equipment and activities onsite.
