

Changes to traffic conditions on Hornibrook Esplanade at Clontarf

Construction is advancing on the \$315 million Houghton Highway Duplication Project between Brighton and Clontarf. Traffic conditions at the northern end of the Houghton Highway bridge will change to enable construction of new approach roads.

Changes scheduled to occur in September 2009 will include the following:

- Southbound traffic approaching the Houghton Highway bridge from Elizabeth Avenue and Hornibrook Esplanade will be redirected around the roadworks.
- Northbound traffic exiting the Houghton Highway bridge at Clontarf will also be redirected around the roadworks.
- At least one lane in each direction will remain open at all times while the roadworks are in progress.
- Access to the old Hornibrook Bridge carpark will be closed to all traffic, to enable the roadworks to be carried out. The carpark may remain closed to traffic for the rest of the construction period. Alternative parking opportunities may be available along Hornibrook Esplanade.

Please note speed limits may be reduced in the construction area. All traffic changes will be signed, and traffic controllers will be in place to direct motorists as required. Signed detour paths and signalised crossings will also be provided for pedestrians and cyclists.
